A BILL

intituled

An Act for making provision to meet additional expenditure for the financial year 1st April 1998 to 31st March 1999.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title

- 1.** This Act may be cited as the Final Supply (FY1998) Act 1999.

Supply \$1,760,000

2.—(1) A further sum of \$1,760,000, not otherwise provided for by the Supply Act 1998 (Act 14 of 1998) and the Supplementary Supply Act 1999 (Act 15 of 1999), is authorised to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for the period from 1st April 1998 to 31st March 1999. 5

(2) The sum specified in subsection (1) is appropriated for the purpose of the Head of Expenditure specified in the Schedule.

In accordance with Articles 148(2) and 148C(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, this Bill seeks to make final provision for the financial year 1st April 1998 to 31st March 1999 to meet expenditure in excess of the sums authorised by the Supply Act 1998 (Act 14 of 1998) and the Supplementary Supply Act 1999 (Act 15 of 1999). Supplementary estimates in respect of the additional provision have been laid before Parliament.
