An Act to provide for making supplementary provision to meet additional expenditure for the financial year 1st April 2001 to 31st March 2002.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Supply (No. 2) Act
5 2001.

Supply \$2,915,000,000

2.—(1) A further sum of \$2,915,000,000, not otherwise provided for by the Supply Act 2001 (Act 6 of 2001), is hereby authorised to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for the period from 1st April 2001 to 31st March 2002.

(2) The sum specified in subsection (1) is hereby appropriated for the purposes of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
