**No. 2268 — MEDICAL REGISTRATION ACT (CAP. 174, 2014 REVISED EDITION)**

*CORRIGENDUM*

It is hereby notified for general information that for the *Gazette* Notification No. 2171 published on 8 July 2024 should read as:

It is hereby notified for general information that, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 55 of the Medical Registration Act (Cap. 174, 2014 Revised Edition), on appeal by the Singapore Medical Council (“**SMC**”) against the decision of the Disciplinary Tribunal (“**DT**”), the Court of Three Judges (“**the Court**”) dismissed the appeal and upheld the DT’s decision and order that the registration of Dr Ling Chia Tien (“**Dr Ling**”) in the Register of Medical Practitioners be suspended from medical practice for a period of **19 months**. Dr Ling was also ordered to be censured, to submit a written undertaking to the SMC to refrain from engaging in the conduct complained of, or any similar conduct, and to pay all the costs and expenses of and incidental to the DT proceedings, including the costs of the Counsel to the SMC, but excluding costs occasioned by the amendments to the Schedules to the Notices of Inquiry made by the SMC on 7 September 2022. Dr Ling’s suspension took effect on 23 January 2024 and will run to 22 August 2025 (both dates inclusive).
